For all residential trips we require all parents/carers to agree to the school's Behaviour and Illness agreement so that we can maintain the health and safety of all children during the trip. Please read the below points and return the reply slip to the office as soon as possible and no later than the 1st April 2019.

Communication:

Please check the schools twitter account (also available to see through our school website) during the trip as we will endeavour to post regular updates on how the children are getting on. Any changes to information will be sent out via parent mail during the trip.

During the trip, you can get a message to the team by contacting school who will in turn contact us. If it is essential to contact us outside of school hours, I can be contacted on the school mobile phone but only in an emergency. You will be provided with this number on the day of the trip.

Please ensure we have the most up to date number to contact you if required, you must remain contactable during the entire trip.

Illness:

In the event of your child becoming ill, we will contact you and you will need to make arrangements to collect your child. We cannot bring your child home to you as we will not have transport or staffing to do so.

Behaviour:

In the event of your child behaving in a way which is deemed inappropriate, disrespectful or dangerous we will contact you and you will need to make arrangements to collect your child immediately. Poor behaviour on the part of individuals won't be tolerated and could lead to an exclusion if they need to be sent home.

We do not wish to do this so please speak seriously with your child about behaving appropriately on the trip. You have paid a great deal of money for this trip and we want this to be a positive experience for all our pupils.
