Dear Parents/Carers.

Your child may be able to get free school meals if you get any of the following:

- Income Support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income
  of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a
  year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)

If you feel you may be entitled to free school meals, you can apply online at this portal address - you will need to register before you use this portal, you should still apply even if your child is in Foundation Stage 2 or class 1 or 2 and gets a free meal due to their age.

We strongly advise you to apply as soon as possible, this will give school the opportunity to order free school meal vouchers for you to use over the summer holidays.
