Dear Parents/Carers,

Our PHSE/ RSHE topic this half term is me, my body and my health. As part of this topic this half term we will be covering 'boys and girls' and beginning to name some of the body parts using correct biological terms. The lesson covering 'private parts' names is next Friday.

The terms we will use are penis, testicles, vulva, vagina and urethra. The topic will teach our children to keep themselves safe and know that private parts are private. In addition to this as part of our safeguarding teaching we will be delivering the NSPCC 'PANTS' programme across EYFS and KS1 next week. This is a programme designed to teach children, at an age appropriate level, that parts of their body covered by their underwear are private and provides them with the language and knowledge to keep themselves safe.
