This weekend, we celebrate Peace Sunday. In his message, Pope Francis on World Peace Day spoke of the importance of fruitful "Dialogue entails listening to one another, sharing different views, coming to agreement and walking together. Promoting such dialogue between generations involves breaking up the hard and barren soil of conflict and indifference in order to sow the seeds of a lasting and shared peace." Pope Francis invited all of us to build the Christian message of peace in our lives and in our society. The Bishops' Conference of England and Wales has asked us to mark this important day as a day of prayer for peace and to reflect on the theme Pope Francis has chosen for the annual World Day of Peace: 'Education, Work and Dialogue between Generations: Tools for Building Lasting Peace'.
