Today, we are halfway through the season of Lent Dear Brothers and Sisters, and we can renew our resolutions. The feast of the Annunciation is celebrated on Friday next 25 March. In the Gospel of St. Luke (Luke1:26-38) we read that the Archangel Gabriel appeared to Mary. "He went in and said to her, 'Rejoice so highly favoured! The Lord is with you" Luke1 28-29. We celebrate Mary's role as the person chosen to be mother of Jesus. Mary is the closest to Jesus and to us too. We pray the prayer Angelus each day said 3 times: at dawn, noon, and dusk, remembering the Angel Gabriel announcing the Birth of our Saviours to Blessed Mother Mary. The exact story of how the Angelus became a common prayer is difficult to parse, but it has a long history. It's thought to have formed from the Franciscan 13th Century tradition of praying three Hail Marys following the ringing of bell at Compline. The Angelus prayer is a daily reminder for us to call to mind God's love for us. Every invitation to pray the Angelus is an opportunity to speak our own "yes" to God. The Angel of the Lord declared unto Mary. R. And she conceived of the Holy Spirit. Hail Mary... Behold the handmaid of the Lord. R. Be it done unto me according to thy word. Hail Mary... And the Word was made flesh. R. And dwelt among us. Hail Mary... Pray for us O holy Mother of God. R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ. Let us Pray. Pour forth we beseech you, O Lord, Thy Grace into our hearts, that we to whom the Incarnation of Christ Thy Son was made known by the message of an angel may by His passion and Cross be brought to the Glory of His Resurrection. Through Christ our Lord. Amen
