Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 6 Transition- Travelling to School

As you know, it is the Academy and governor's decision that all pupils be accompanied on the journey to and from school to ensure their safety. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter. In the summer term, as part of a transition programme to prepare the pupils for secondary school, we will be agreeing to pupils in Year 6 travelling to and from school unaccompanied from **Monday 13th April 2026, the first day back after half term**, with signed parental agreement.

Pupils travelling to and from school are wearing school uniform and therefore represent St Patrick's School. With this in mind, their behaviour on the journey must be safe, sensible and respectful of people they pass. If they bring the school into disrepute as a result of their behaviour or language used, behaviour sanctions will apply and potentially exclusion depending upon the nature of the incident. The agreement for children to walk home alone would be evoked and children would need to be brought to and from school by an adult. Please stress this with your child so that we can ensure they end their time at St Patrick's School in a positive way. We hope and trust that all our Year 6 pupils will rise to this challenge and prove themselves to be sensible, safe and responsible.

In order for your child to be released to walk home alone at the end of the day from Monday 13th April 2026, please complete and return to the school office the attached agreement slip by **Thursday 26th March 2026**.

Any child who doesn't return a signed agreement slip will not be allowed to go home alone and we will call you to collect them. We are very happy for parents who wish to collect and bring their child to school to continue to do so.

If your child attends an after school extra-curricular club or SAT's boosters (**not including TB Sports Wraparound Care**), your child will also be allowed to walk home alone from these sessions with permission.

Please note, all other pupils in other year groups will still need to be collected by an adult over 16 even if their Year 6 brother or sister is walking home alone.
