Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost. For us, it is a commemorative day when the Holy Spirit descended on the apostles and the Virgin Mary in the form of fiery tongues, an event that took place fifty days after the resurrection of Jesus. The Paschal mystery of the Passion, the Death, the Resurrection, and the Ascension of Jesus culminates in the sending of the Holy Spirit by the Father at the request of His Son on Jesus' disciples. The feast also commemorates the official inauguration of the Church by the apostolic preaching of St. Peter which resulted in the conversion of 3,000 Jews to the Christian faith. Pentecost is, thus, the official birthday of the Church. May this celebration inspire us to pray for a new Pentecost in our lives, our parish, and our world, and allow us become smarter partners of the Holy Spirit.
