Today's celebration of the solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ originated in the Diocese of Liege in 1246 as the feast of Corpus Christi. In the changes of Vatican II, Corpus Christi was joined with the feast of the Precious Blood (July 1) to become the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of the Lord.

We celebrate today Christ's gift of the Eucharist, the source and summit of our life together as the Church. Today, when we do receive Holy Communion, with Christ inside us, we can open our hearts to Him. In this regard, St. Francis de Sales advises us as follows: "When you have received Him, stir up your heart to do Him homage; speak to Him about your spiritual life, gazing upon Him in your soul where He is present for your happiness; welcome Him as warmly as possible, and behave outwardly in such a way that your actions may give proof to all of His Presence."
