Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today we celebrate 'World Mission Sunday'. Since 1926, the Catholic Church has set aside the month of October to remember the Church's universal mission. In 1926 Pope Pius XI, first called the church together to keep a day of prayer for missions. On this day, every person in every parish in the world where the church is present will be called to celebrate the missionary activity abroad (*Ad Gentes*) through sharing what they have, no matter how little, especially through prayer, sacrifice and financial donations. The financial donations are collected on this day and will go to support Churches, hospitals, schools and vocations in countries where the church is struggling or too young to support themselves. This year *Missio* in England and Wales the Catholic Church focuses its attention on helping countless young girls who are exploited through child trafficking and child labour. Often these young ones are stolen from their families or sold against their will, these children become trapped in lives of poverty and despair. Through the help of us, the Papal Charity *Missio* has enabled local communities to work hard to rescue those suffering. We draw inspiration from Mary and pray in these words;



Hail Mary, model of missionaries, pray with us for those who suffer, inspire us to reach out and ease their struggles. Pray with us for those who rely on our generosity, help us to share freely. Pray with us for those who lack humility, may we learn the value of asking others for help. Pray for us that we might be courageous witnesses of your Son's love. Joyfully carrying into this world Christ's light and hope. Amen.
