### **CORONAVIRUS**

Following concerns from parishioners, the Bishop has issued the following advice regarding the sign of peace & receiving from the chalice at Mass. Public Health England continues to assess the current risk to the UK as low and reminds people of the obvious sensible guidelines. Bishop Patrick offers the obvious common-sense precautions to parishioners, namely covering one's mouth and nose while sneezing or coughing & regular washing of hands. If anyone feels uncomfortable about shaking hands at the sign of peace, then they could bow to the other person and say: 'Peace be with you'. If anyone feels uncomfortable, for the moment, about receiving from the chalice, then they could refrain from doing so.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This Tuesday, February 11 is World Day of the Sick. Pope John Paul II initiated the day in 1992 to encourage people to pray for those who suffer from illness and for their caregivers. The designated day of the sick allowed a way for us Catholics all around the globe to offer prayers for those suffering from illnesses. On the same day, we also celebrate the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. On this day we are invited to take the time to pray for the sick and the caregivers who work hard to look after the sick. The theme of this year's observance of World Day of the Sick is "Come to me, all you who labour and are burdened, and I will give you rest," taken from Matthew's Gospel (11:28). Pope Francis in his message for this day says, "In your experience of illness, you certainly need a place to find rest. The Church desires to become more and more the "inn" of the Good Samaritan who is Christ (cf. Lk 10:34), that is, a home where you can encounter his grace, which finds expression in closeness, acceptance and relief." He continued to appreciate the hard-work put into helping the infirm and sick by healthcare workers by these words, "A key role in this effort to offer rest and renewal to our sick brothers and sisters is played by healthcare workers: physicians, nurses, medical and administrative professionals, assistants and volunteers. Thanks to their expertise, they can make patients feel the presence of Christ who consoles and cares for the sick, and heals every hurt." We as a parish community give thanks to all the healthcare workers and family members who take care of the elderly and the infirm. May Christ who heals us guide them and bless them.
