

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We may hear some time people say, "I just had a super busy day today, converting oxygen into Carbon dioxide". We may be saying the same way as others say. We never had time to pause and reflect during the day. Daily examine is a great tool for busy people to help them see God's hand at work in their whole experience on that day.

A 'daily examine' is a prayer. The steps of the prayer by following the simple formula of G-plus-3. The "G" stands for "Gratitude". First, before we go to sleep, we render our gratitude to God for whatever blessings were most apparent during the day. Then comes the "3". That stands for taking a quick look at how we lived our three most important relationships throughout the day. The first relationship is with God. Did I pray today? Did I pay attention to God? Did I obey my conscience? The second relationship is with other people. Did I love my neighbour as myself? The third relationship is with our self. Did I give into pleasure-seeking, laziness, or irresponsibility? Review of these steps allows us to see the victories to rejoice in and failures to repent on. That gives a chance for God to heal us and strengthen us for tomorrow.
